CasinoTrac – First came TableTrac, a company that created a table games management system providing accounting, reporting, player tracking, and reward information that could be integrated with other third-party casino management systems. In due time it grew and the need for a complete management system was in demand. From this CasinoTrac was developed. CasinoTrac is a suite of casino management products to be used across an entire slot floor. The system has regulatory approval and is licensed in several states as well as tribal and international jurisdictions.

IGT is selling 1,250 historical horse racing machines to Churchill Downs. IGT will be placing the games on three types of its new cabinets: CrystalDual 27, CrystalSlant and CrystalCurve.

The machines will operate using Ainsworth's historical racing management system at four of Churchill's properties in Kentucky – three current facilities and one that is currently being built.

IGT has upsized its senior secured notes offer from \$300 million to \$750 million at 5.25 percent interest.

Maturing in 2029, these new notes will be placed privately in the US and will not be registered for trading.

TableTrac has already assisted several casino partners in the US and Caribbean and will continue to work with properties in California, Iowa and Nevada.

TableTrac was chosen to supply its CasinoTrac management system to Fernley Nugget Casino in Fernley, Nevada, which is outside of Reno.

TableTrac contracted with Jackpot Crossing Casino in Fernley, Nevada to use its CasinoTrac casino management system.
